- "A Brown Teddy Bear named Tim. This may explain my first breakup with my girlfriend..." - Brad Lichota, National Chief

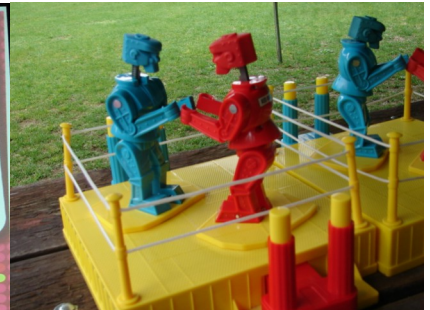
Why do they leave bank vaults open during the day but chain their pens to the table?
